In 1931, when women's education was scarcely prevalent, Late Rai Bahadur Harekrishna Das Khun Khun Ji established the Khun Khun Ji Anglo-Vernacular Girls' Middle School by inviting teachers from outside the province. Over time, this humble initiative evolved into the Khun Khun Ji Girls' Post Graduate College. His son, Shri Krishnadas Khun Khun Ji, carried forward his father's noble vision with dedication and foresight.

In 1959, the college was recognized by the University of Lucknow to conduct B.A. classes under the Faculty of Arts, and in 1974, B.Ed. classes were introduced under the Faculty of Education. Continuing this legacy of growth, under the guidance of the former manager Shri Omprakash Agarwal Ji, the institution expanded its academic offerings with equal devotion and commitment. In 2023, the college further diversified its academic scope by introducing the B.Com. course, duly recognized by the University of Lucknow.
